Professional Development Points

Since the inception of our Professional Development Program in 2005, Heritage Festivals has issued over 5,000 transcripts to music educators worldwide. We continue to offer participants **Professional Development Points/Hours** (PDPs), tailored specifically to state recertification requirements, for traveling to a Heritage festival. The number of PDPs available to educators is dependent upon your travel program:

To claim your PDPs, simply accompany students to one of our renowned festivals and complete a transcript request form online at www.heritagefestivals.org/pdptranscript either before or after you travel.

Each transcript is tailored to your state's requirements for re-certification and includes State Board of Education approval codes, if applicable.

Course 1000: East Coast History	
<i>Applicable to all WorldStrides East Coast History programs</i>	
University granting credit: <i>(choose one)</i>	Augustana College – Sioux Falls, SD Colorado State University – Pueblo, CO North Dakota State University – Fargo, ND University of St. Thomas – St. Paul, MN
Cost:	1 credit = \$99 2 credits = \$185 3 credits = \$350
<p>In this course, participants experience a number of unique learning venues in the Washington, D.C. area. Information gained from these field experiences can be used by educators in a variety of ways: as a resource for students, a field experience site, and a resource for professional growth. Self-guided tours and exploration invite participants to explore ways to incorporate activities and sites into their curriculum and school programs.</p>	

Course 1001: Independent Travel Study

Cost:	\$165 per credit (up to four credits)
<p>Make plans to learn while you explore exciting domestic and international destinations through WorldStrides' travel study programs. This learning program enriches your travel experiences through special visits and contacts, as well as knowledge of the culture, history, language and tradition of your destination. Earn credit for a planned learning experience while traveling in the United States or abroad in all subject areas! Applicants for this program are required to write a paper of any topic that relates your travel experience to your teaching in the classroom/school environment.</p>
